3. Medium small dark moth at sugar bait, env. C – 17:37

5. Medium small dark moth at sugar bait, env. E – 18:12
6. Zale moth at sugar bait, env. F – 18:14
7. Medium small brown moth at sugar bait, env. G – 18:52
8. Tiny moth at front door of building, env. H – 19:06

One tree had four moths on the bait. Briefly heard two leopard frogs.
