With Doug Veal. When I turned the light off, there were about a dozen moths on the sheet. Set up about 80 yards down the southern trail from the top of Woodpecker Hill. Saw no underwings, zales, sphinx moth, or saturnids. Several additional <u>Haploa</u> moths came to the sheet in addition to the Haploa caught (see #5). Also had one <u>Wavy-lined Emerald</u> come to the sheet. Central City got four inches of rain after we left; we could see lots of lightning in the west and northwest on the way home.
